Masonic Trivia:

In *Hammer v. State*, 173 Indiana, 199 (1909), the Supreme Court ruled that it was a criminal offense to wear the emblem of any society or organization of which one is not a member. The court based its decision on the fact that the membership in such societies is the result of fitness and selection and that the wearing of such emblems by non-members is a deceit and false pretense.

Four people sent in an answer and they all got it right: Dave Fowler, Dean Millard, Henry Spoomer, and Roy Peters. If I missed anyone I apologize but when you are knee deep in alligators it is hard to remember the original mission was to drain the swamp. Jerry Estruth informed that he had the baseball puzzle correct the other day. **Solution:** The 8th child is directly opposite the 20th child. Since $20 - 8 = 12$, there are 12 children in half the circle. (Note that half the circle includes one child out of the 8th child and the 20th child.) Thus, there are 24 children altogether in the full circle. **Food for thought:** Is it critical that the children be evenly spaced in the circle? Is it critical where the counting of the children begins from?
