

Resolution 2007-11
(requires a majority to approve)

Synopsis: This Resolution removes Grand Masters Decision 62.2 from the Arizona Masonic Code because the condition it addresses is covered in Decision No. 62.7. It is possible that this was overlooked when Decision No. 62.7 was approved in 1966. There is no need for the older decision 62.2, which covers only the “25-year button.” Decision 62.7 covers both awards.

Added text in **bold type**, removed text in ~~strikethrough~~:

Decision No. 62.2 ~~In the case of a Brother who was a member for a number of years, then suspended for non payment of dues and later reinstated, both periods of his membership shall be considered in determining whether he is entitled to receive a 25 year button.~~
Abrogated 2007.

Decision No. 62.7, which remains in effect, reads: “A member cannot restore continuity for either the 25-year award or the 50-year award of membership by later paying dues for the period of suspension. The award must be calculated by the number of years served in good standing, not from the date of the Third Degree.”
