

Resolution 2007-13
(requires a majority to approve)

Synopsis: This Resolution removes Grand Masters Decision 115 from the Arizona Masonic Code because it ceased to have any practical effect when the Grand Lodge of Arizona resumed normal Masonic relations with the Grand Lodge of Cuba in 1987. An unaffiliated Mason with a demit from the Grand Lodge of Cuba is eligible to affiliate with any Arizona Lodge, using his Demit as evidence of previous good standing. Current members of the GL of Cuba may apply for either dual membership or transfer of membership the same as Masons from any other recognized Grand Lodge.

Decision No. 115. ~~A former member of the Grand Lodge of Cuba with no current dues card may join a Lodge by (1) establishing his credentials in a jurisdiction recognizing the exiled Grand Lodge of Cuba and affiliate there, or (2) petition for the degrees as a non-Mason.~~ **Abrogated 2007.**
