

## **Resolution 2007-2**

(Requires a simple majority to adopt)

Synopsis: This resolution abrogates Grand Master's Decision 31.2, and results in giving the Grand Master greater flexibility in assisting lodges to meet the needs of their members.

Whereas lodges in Arizona must continually monitor their performance to insure that they are meeting the needs of their members, and must therefore have the flexibility to try changes to their operations before making those changes permanent; and

Whereas from time to time it is necessary for the Grand Master to have the authority to make decisions for the best interests of Freemasonry in Arizona the following legislation is offered for Consideration;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Grand Masters Decision No. 31.2 be abrogated (added text in **bold type**, deletions in ~~striketrough~~).

No. 31.2 ~~The Grand Master has no power to authorize a lodge to violate its own by laws, the lodge's correct course of action being to amend its by laws.~~ **Abrogated 2007**
