

Resolution 2007-05
(requires a 5/6 Majority to adopt)

Synopsis: The purpose of this resolution is to reduce the number of candidates a Lodge may confer degrees upon at one time, and during any one meeting. The adoption of this resolution will increase personal attention given to the candidate, and increase brotherly love. It will result in a stronger bond between the candidate and their Lodge by approaching the degrees of Freemasonry with courtesy to the candidate and respect to the traditions of the Craft.

Additions in **bold type**, deletions in ~~strickthrough~~:

Section 84. No Lodge shall confer degrees upon more than ~~five~~ **three** candidates at any one meeting; nor shall it confer more than one degree upon any one candidate at any one meeting; nor shall it confer any of the degrees upon more than ~~three~~ **one candidate** ~~candidates~~ at a time.
